Dear Chief Justice George and Honorable Associates Justices:

This letter is being submitted to urge the Supreme Court to accept review of Mr. Benninghoff's plea for help.

My interest in this case is that I am a citizen hoping that Your Honors will do justice in Mr. Benninghoff's case and not create a judicial crime after the fact. I was told, and do believe, that Mr. Benninghoff was representing people before California agencies after having received Legislative Counsel Opinion #18108 that specifically stated he could do so.

The writing of law rests with the Legislature, not the courts. Therefore, if Mr. Benninghoff is not to be allowed to do agency work as a resigned attorney, and as the Legislative Counsel so wrote, then it is up to the Legislature to write the laws accordingly. This issue is of great public interest, because if the courts continue to rewrite law, then our State Constitution is moot and we become a state of men and not of law.

Another underlying issue at stake is that of health freedom in general. I am a retired military pilot, having served 32 years in the Air Force. My wife was diagnosed with ovarian cancer in 2001. We wanted treatment other than what is commonly called "conventional", believing this was the best course of action. We had to leave the "land of freedom" to obtain true health freedom, which was very upsetting to us. We felt our government was telling us what was best for us instead of letting us freely decide for ourselves. People such as Mr. Benninghoff are needed to help others with their efforts to either practice or receive health care other than what is sanctioned by the FDA and AMA. Please do not deprive Americans of something as basic as health freedom by stifling his efforts.


