Dear Chief Justice George and Honorable Associates Justices:

This letter is being submitted to urge the Supreme Court to accept review of Mr. Benninghoff's plea for help.


While my interest in this case is that of a citizen, it's also as executive director of an organization representing some 200 referral doctors, many of whom have, one time or another, been wrongly accused of practicing medicine contrary to various state and federal laws simply because they do not believe in prescribing symptom relieving drugs as opposed to seeking true, remedial causation. People like Mr. Benninghoff, at great financial sacrifice, have voluntarily helped protect many of these medical pioneers.

I was told, and do believe, that Mr. Benninghoff was representing people before California agencies after having received Legislative Counsel Opinion #18108 that specifically stated he could do so.

The writing of law rests with the Legislature, not the courts. Therefore, if Mr. Benninghoff is not to be allowed to do agency work as a resigned attorney, and as the Legislative Counsel so wrote, then it is up to the Legislature to write the laws accordingly.

This issue is of great public interest, because if the courts continue to write and rewrite law, then both the Federal Constitution and the various State Constitutions are moot, and we shall descend to a state of rule by appointed men, not of law.


