Dear Chief Justice George and Honorable Associates Justices:

Please review Mr. Benninghoff's plea for help. I am hoping that Your Honors will do justice in Mr. Benninghoff's case and not create a judicial crime after the fact.

I was told, and do believe, that Mr. Benninghoff was representing people before California agencies after having received Legislative Counsel Opinion #18108 that specifically stated he could do so since he was no longer a practicing attorney.

The writing of law rests with the Legislature, not the courts. Therefore, it is up to the Legislature to write the laws accordingly, not for courts to create their own as they go – case law aside.

This issue is of great public interest, because if the courts continue to rewrite law, then our State Constitution is moot. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
