Dear Chief Justice George and Honorable Associates Justices:

I am writing this letter to urge the Supreme Court to accept the review of Mr. Benninghoff's plea for help before the law. I am an interested citizen, businessman, and veteran who is hoping that Your Honors will do justice in Mr. Benninghoff's case. I was told and do believe that Mr. Benninghoff was representing people before California agencies, based upon the fact that he had sought and received Legislative Counsel Opinion #18108 that stated specifically that he could do so. I am sure that he never would have started the California administrative work without official approval.

The writing of law rests with the Legislature and not with the courts. Therefore, if Mr. Benninghoff is not allowed to do agency work as a resigned attorney, and as the Legislative Counsel so wrote, then surely it rests with the Legislature to revise the laws accordingly. This issue is of great public interest, because if the courts continue to rewrite law, then our State Constitutions are moot, and we become a disorganized state of individuals and not of law.


I am a licensed insurance broker, and operate an independent agency representing a number of insurance companies in the Metropolitan Washington, D.C. area. Additionally, I am a National Director of the Catholic War Veterans of the USA (2003 – present.) I have been active in both insurance and veterans matters for many years.

I have known Charles Benninghoff for nearly forty years. From 1967 to 1968, we served together in the U.S. Navy River Patrol Force in the Republic of Vietnam. Mr. Benninghoff was a good Boat Captain and an outstanding Tactical Operations Center (TOC) Watch Petty Officer. While serving at Cua Viet, six kilometers south of the Demilitarized Zone for six months, he always conducted himself professionally and courageously under consistently hazardous conditions.

Mr. Benninghoff's record of service to country and community has continued for more than three decades. He presently serves as the National Secretary of the Gamewardens of Vietnam, Inc. Founded in 1968, it is the oldest, continuously operating Vietnam veterans group in the USA. In the 1970s, 1980s, and 1990s, he and his wife, Nancy, were leaders in Orange County, CA volunteerism, spending many hours in community service. Charles and Nancy Benninghoff are the loving parents of two fine children, and continue to be strong supporters of their community. This is a good man, who is appealing to you for justice.

In view of the above, I strongly recommend that you review Mr. Benninghoff's case. Please let me know if there are any questions. I declare that these statements are true to the best of my knowledge and belief.


