Dear Chief Justice George and Honorable Associates Justices:

I am writing to you on behalf of Mr. Charles F. Benninghoff to urge the Supreme Court to review Mr. Benninghoff's plea for help

I am hoping that Your Honors will do justice in Mr. Benninghoff's case. He was representing people as a resigned attorney and should be allowed to do what a nonattorney can do unless specifically prohibited by a law or regulation. My understanding is that Mr. Benninghoff was working under Legislative Counsel Opinion #18108 which allows nonattorney's to represent people at an administrative hearing. A resigned attorney may provide representation at an administrative hearing on the same basis as any other nonattorney.

In the State of California the writing of law is in the Legislature, not the courts. If Mr. Benninghoff is not allowed to do agency work as a resigned attorney, it is up to the legislature to write the law accordingly.

Mr. Benninghoff's case is of interest to me and all citizens who worry about the courts writing the laws and not California State Legislature, which is the purpose of an elected legislature.

Please take note of this case; it is in the interest of all citizens of California.
